- ACDS serves as the administrator and financial steward for Anne Arundel County's housing and community development funds and programs, including community development initiatives and programs to end homelessness
- ACDS secures and administers funds on behalf on other nonprofit organizations, while providing technical guidance, financial management and construction expertise to help complete major projects
- ACDS was created by Anne Arundel County in 1993 to administer federal, State and County dollars available for housing and community development programs, projects and activities.

OUR MISSION

REVITALIZE declining neighborhoods through the targeting of joint public and private investment.

PRESERVE and increase the supply of affordable housing for tenants and owners through comprehensive property rehabilitation programs.

PROMOTE homeownership through financial support, homebuyer education and construction of affordable units.

ENSURE housing for those with special needs, including the homeless, the elderly, and the physically and mentally challenged.

ENHANCE the quality of life in low income communities by providing community facilities and services to children, youth, and families, and supporting job training.

PRESERVE the County's rich cultural history through wide-ranging restoration efforts.

HIGHLIGHTS FOR 2013-2017

- ◊ Provided financing and technical assistance to help 155 low income homeowners rehabilitate their homes.
- ◊ Provided homeownership and foreclosure counseling to over 5,224 households.
- ◊ Provided financing for the construction or redevelopment of 312 affordable rental units.
- Supported programs that boosted over 711 families and individuals' economic independence through child care, transportation, and training.
- $\diamond\,$ Provided financing to prevent 1,413 households from becoming homeless.
- $\diamond\,$ Supported temporary and transitional shelter programs which housed 5,078 homeless persons.
- $\diamond\,$ Supported 1,744 low-income youth and children participation in after-school enrichment activities.
- Veatherized over 500 single and multi-family housing units serving low-income residents and made energy efficient retrofits and/or installed renewable energy systems to eight County-owned senior centers and fire stations.
