**Purpose of Annual Action Plan:** The Annual Action Plan presents a detailed strategy for the use of CDBG, HOME, ESG, HOPWA and COC grant funds expected to be received by the County during Local Fiscal Year 2020 to implement eligible activities in achieving fifth year objectives of the County *Consolidated Plan: FY 2016 - FY 2020*. The Annual Action Plan also includes proposed amendments to previous Action Plans.
