## What? How much?

- **WHAT: Strategic Priorities**  
**RECOMMENDATION: OSE Survey Preferences**
  - Mental Health and substance abuse services
  - Education and after-school programs; and
  - Housing and homelessness prevention services
- **HOW MUCH: What should be the grant amount range?**  
**RECOMMENDATION: \$20,000 - \$75,000**

**RECOMMENDATION:** Year 1 DIA ZIP codes will have funding priority; however, organizations serving low-income individuals/communities will be eligible to apply.

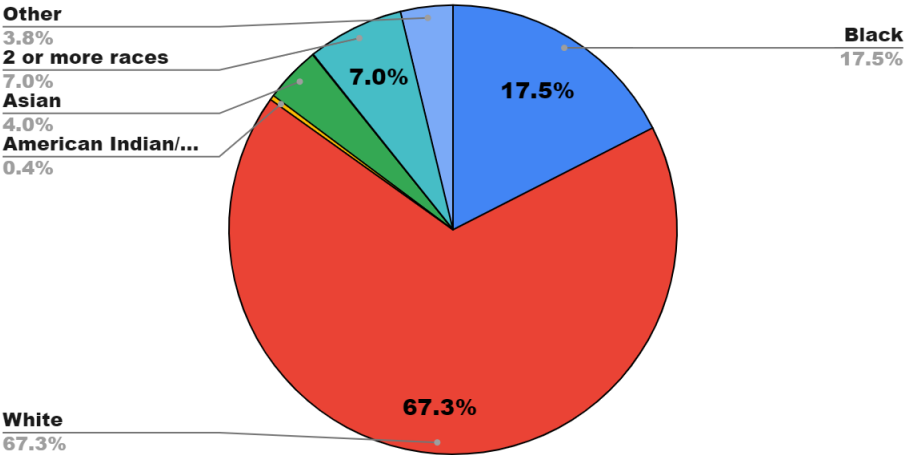

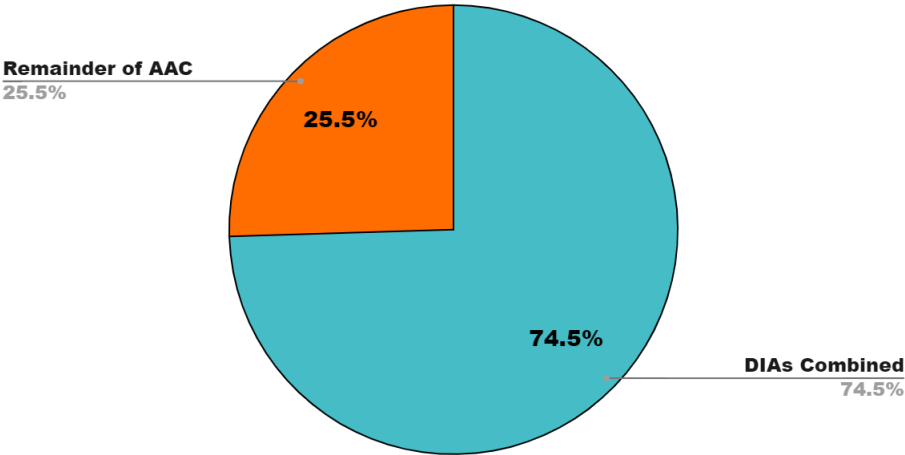
### Racial Demographics of Anne Arundel County

**Population: 593,286**



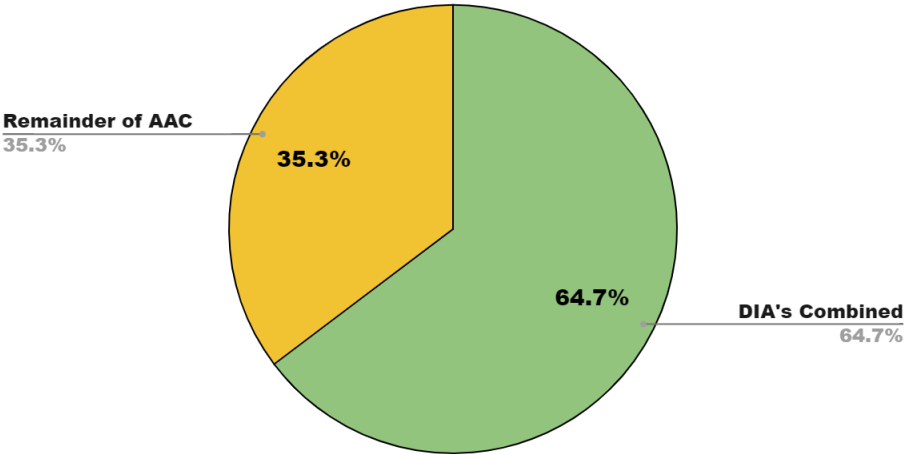
### Black Population in Anne Arundel County
