FY27 Funding Recommendations

Education, Youth Enrichment, and After-School Activities

Methodology:

- All applicants that received a score of 90% or above are recommended to receive a multi-year grant at 79% of their annual requested amount for two years
- All multi-year applicants that received a score of 80% or above are recommended to receive a single-year grant for their annual requested amount
- All single-year applicants that received a score of 80% or above are recommended to receive a single-year grant for \$25,000

Housing and Homelessness Prevention

Methodology:

- All applicants were considered based on their single year funding request – multi-year grants were not considered
- Applicants were ranked based on their rubric score from highest to lowest, with the top scored applications being recommended for funding
- Recommended funding amounts were determined by multiplying an applicants single year funding request by their rubric score (i.e. an applicant who scored 95% on the rubric received 95% of their single-year request)
- Recommended funding amounts were rounded down to the nearest \$5,000 mark
- All remaining funds were allocated to the next highest scored applicant

Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services

Methodology:

- All applicants were considered based on their single year funding request – multi-year grants were not considered
- Applicants were ranked based on their rubric score from highest to lowest, with the top scored applications being recommended for funding
- The top 12 scored applicants were recommended to receive their full single year request

- A balance of \$2,000 in available funds was recommended to be allocated to the top scored applicant

Workforce Development and Employment Training

Methodology:

- All applicants that received a score of 80% or above were recommended to receive their full request
- Discover Church, which scored above 80%, was recommended to receive a multi-year grant at an amount less than requested due to already receiving a funding recommendation for a separate program from the Education, Youth Enrichment, and After-School Activities committee
- The remaining balance of the available funds was recommended to be evenly distributed to all applicants scoring at or above 75%, with the exception of Autism Society who only requested \$25,000 per year
